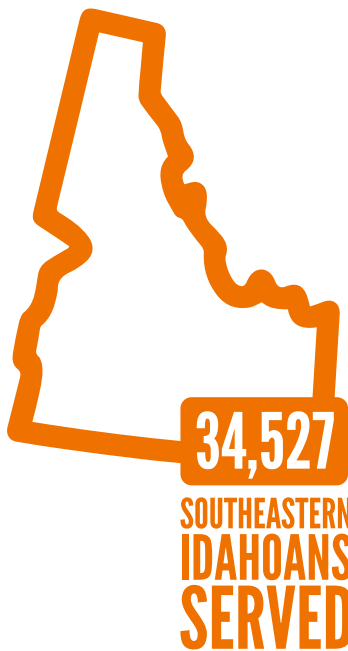




COMMUNITY FUND IMPACT

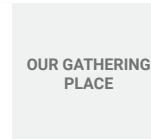
6TH JUDICIAL CASA IN CARIBOU COUNTY

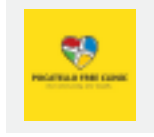
EMERGENCY HOMELESS SHELTER

Provides shelter, basic necessities and case management to homeless individuals and families.



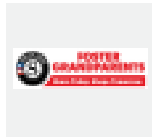
OUR GATHERING PLACE

Provides nutritious snacks, safe physical space, and mentoring to high school aged students.



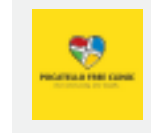
ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE OF UNINSURED ADULTS WITH MENTAL DISTRESS

Free and confidential advocacy and counseling services to victims of abuse and violence in Southeastern Idaho.



HOMEOWNER REPAIR & RENOVATION PROJECTS

Assists low- and moderate-income homeowners with critical repairs to help preserve the life, health and safety of their homes.



RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (RSVP)

A volunteer management program that recruits and places individuals age 55 and older in non-profit and/or public settings throughout Southeastern Idaho's seven counties.



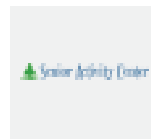
AREA V AGENCY ON AGING SENIOR NUTRITION PROGRAM

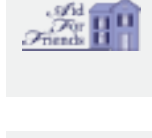
SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER CONGREGATE NUTRITION PROGRAM

Healthy meals and socialization for individuals age 60 and older and persons with disabilities.



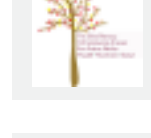
BABYSTEPS PROGRAM

An education and incentive program for families who are pregnant or have a child under 18 months of age.



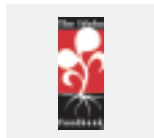
KITCHEN APPLIANCES FOR NEW FACILITY

Commercial grade kitchen equipment for the new facility to increase the number of people who receive nutritious meals in the homeless shelter.



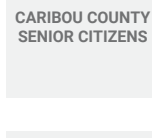
SHELLEY AREA CITIZENS

Provides essential services to the senior population of Northern Bingham County.



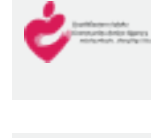
BACKPACK PROGRAM

UWSEI funds will be used to obtain an updated embroidery machine to train people with disabilities and to prepare them to enter the job market with skills for future employment.



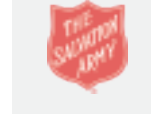
BRIGHT TOMORROWS CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER

NURTURING PARENTS DEVELOPMENT & KINDERGARTEN READINESS PLAYGROUPS

Offers kindergarten readiness groups to 4 and 5-year-old children free of cost.



THE SALVATION ARMY FOOD PANTRY

Provides nutritious food items in the food pantry.



COMMUNITIES ALIGNED IN PREVENTION EFFORTS PROGRAM (CAPE)

Brings together individuals, organizations, government entities and communities throughout Eastern Idaho for the prevention of childhood abuse, neglect and trauma.
